# Azure Plan: Introducción

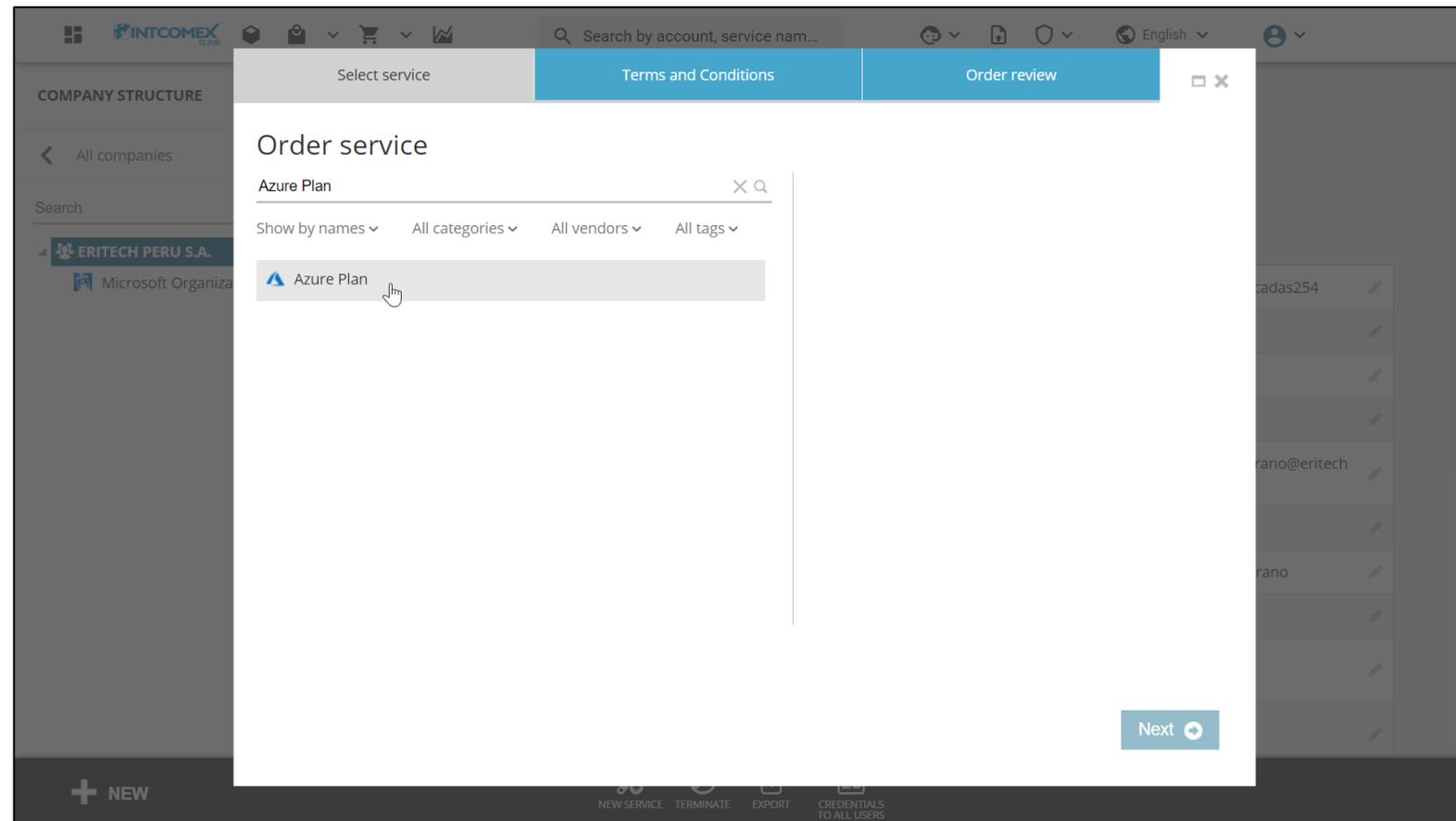
