In the **Select Service** tab, type **Microsoft Organization Tenant** in the search box. Then, click the **Next** button.





In the **Terms and Conditions** tab, accept the general terms of the **Microsoft Cloud Agreement** (MCA). Then, click the **Next** button.

Provisioning a tenant in ICP Procedure: Existing tenant

In the **Configuration** tab, two different scenarios may arise:

The first occurs when the end customer already has an existing tenant and needs to provision Microsoft services within it. The second occurs when the end customer does not have a tenant. In both cases, the required information must be registered to proceed with the tenant provisioning process.

If an end customer informs us that they already have a tenant where they manage their Microsoft 365 licenses, we must request their support in accepting a commercial relationship link with Intcomex. Once the end customer accepts the invitation, Intcomex gains basic permissions that allow only license provisioning.

To complete this process, the reseller must request the corresponding link from the assigned Intcomex PM. This link can be used for any other customer in the same country.





Once the end customer has accepted the relationship link, you can proceed with the provisioning process. To do this, check the **Existing Office 365 Customer** box.





Next, in the **Primary Domain Name** field, enter the primary domain of the end customer's tenant, which always follows the syntax <PrimaryDomain>.onmicrosoft.com. As a best practice, it's recommended to always request a screenshot of the domains configured in the customer's tenant to verify the information.





Next, in the **Microsoft Partner ID** field, enter your organization's MPN ID. If you don't have a valid MPN ID yet because it's still in process, you can leave this field blank.





Next, in the **State** field, enter the state or region where the end customer's company is located. Then, click the **Next** button.





Finally, click the **Finish** button to initiate the provisioning event.

Provisioning a tenant in ICP Procedure: New tenant

If an end customer does not have a tenant, you can create one for them free of charge. First, uncheck the **Existing Office 365 customer** box.





Next, in the **Primary Domain Name** field, enter the primary domain the end customer wants.





In the Language field, select the language for the tenant.





Next, in the **Require password change** field, check the box if you want the end customer to change their default administrator password after logging into the Office portal for the first time.





In the **DEFAULT GDAP ROLES** section, there is a checkbox that you can select if you want Intcomex to have basic support permissions for the tenant being created. The granted roles are displayed in the **About default GDAP roles** field. These permissions are valid for 180 days. After this period, the end customer must accept a new GDAP link to continue receiving support services.





Next, in the **Microsoft Partner ID** field, enter your organization's MPN ID. If you don't have a valid MPN ID yet because it's still being processed, you can leave this field blank.





Then, check the **Accept MCA** box to confirm that you agree to the terms and conditions of the Microsoft Customer Agreement. If you want more details, you can click the links displayed in the **Information** field.





Next, fill in the **First Name, Last Name, Email Address**, and **Phone Number** fields with the information of the end customer's user who agrees to the terms and conditions of the MCA. Then, enter the date of acceptance in the **Date of Acceptance** field. Afterward, click the **Next** button.





Finally, click the **Finish** button to initiate the provisioning process.
